Sir,

In continuation of Commission letter of even no. dated. 20.01.2012 I am directed to say that the Commission has re-considered the matter and has directed that in case where photo of elector in the voter list and /or in EPIC is wrong. The following measures should be taken

- (a) If photo is wrong in PER but correct in EPIC – Identification can be allowed to be made through EPIC.
- (b) Where photo is wrong in EPIC but correct in PER – Identification should be allowed photo in PER.
- (c) Where photo is wrong both in PER and EPIC – Identification should allowed through list of alternative document along-with EPIC/ Voter slips.

This may be brought to the notice of all concerned for strict compliance
