Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to the Commission's guidelines for smooth management of postal ballot papers circulated vide its letter No. 52/2008/JS-II dated 21.10.2008 and to request to you ensure that the instructions are strictly implemented in order to enable all personnel deployed on election duty to exercise their voting right. The said letter also contains instructions to be followed for issue of postal ballot papers for service voters belonging to Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces. The letter referred to above is reproduced at serial No 25 of the Compendium of Instructions- volume-2.

2. The instructions for dispatch of postal ballot papers to service voters who are posted in Indian Missions abroad are contained in the Commission's letter No.52/1/84 dated 06.11.1984, reproduced at serial No. 26 of the Compendium of Instructions- volume-2.
