Incidents of disruption of polls due to other reasons (specify)	1. In Karimganj District in 4-Karimganj South AC in PS No. 77 Poll was stopped because presiding officer forgot to press the ballot button on EVM for 30 voters. Form 17-A was showing 180 voters while EVM total was 150 votes

In Karimganj District there was poll boycott in 15 Polling Stations in protest of lack of development 3.
