ATTENTION KASHMIRI MIGRANTS

(i) The General Election to the House of the People to constitute a new House has been announced by the Commission. According to the schedule fixed for the purpose, the election to the House of the People from the State of Jammu and Kashmir will be held in four phases as detailed below:-

(ii) The Election Commission has worked out a scheme to enable the Kashmiri migrants electors, who are residing at various relief camps in Delhi, Jammu, Udhampur and nearby areas to cast their votes in person at the above mentioned general elections at any of the following polling stations:-

(iii) Those who wish to exercise their franchise in person, should intimate details of the electors of their families to the Assistant Returning Officers mentioned below in prescribed form "M ". The Option once given shall be final. The electoral rolls of the aforesaid three Parliamentary Constituencies have been kept for inspection in the offices of the following Assistant Electoral Registration Officers of the aforesaid Parliamentary Constituencies. The Kashmiri Migrants living in Jammu, Delhi or elsewhere, who wish to enroll themselves as electors or get their names corrected or any names deleted from the electoral rolls may apply in the prescribed Form so as to reach the said officers by 03rd April, 2004.

(iv) All the Kashmiri Migrants (other than those who opt to vote in person) have the option to vote through postal ballot papers. They may apply for the postal ballot paper in the prescribed Form 12 C available in the offices of the Asstt. Returning Officers mentioned above.

(v) All migrant voters are requested to send their forms (**Forms 12C** or **Form M**) duly filed in and attested to the concerned Assistant Returning Officers so as to reach them on or before **10th April, 2004** in respect of 1-Baramulla Parliamentary Constituency, on or before **16th April, 2004** in respect of 2- Srinagar Parliamentary Constituency and on or before **25th April, 2004** in respect of 3-Anantnag Parliamentary Constituency.

(vi) To facilitate attestation of Form 12C and Form M, sufficient number of Gazetted Officers will be available in the offices of the Assistant Returning Officers.

(vii) All migrant electors can post their application Forms and later on their marked postal ballot papers in the special letter boxes which will be available at the offices of the Assistant Returning Officers.

ATTENTION BRU /REANG MIGRANTS

(i) The General Election to Lok Sabha to constitute a new House has been announced by the Commission. According to the schedule fixed for the purpose, the poll in the Mizoram Parliamentary Constituency in the State Mizoram will be held on 20th April, 2004.

(ii) In terms of Section 60(c) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, the Election Commission, in consultation with the Central Government has notified the Bru/Reang Migrants belonging to 1- Mizoram Parliamentary Constituency and presently settled outside the place of their ordinary residences , as notified class of voters, for the purpose of facilitating the exercise of their franchise in the aforesaid general election through postal ballot and postal ballot only.

(iii) All the Bru/Reang may apply for the postal ballot paper in the prescribed Form 12C available in the offices of the Assistant Returning Officers mentioned above.
