Subject: General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Goa, 2012 - Concession to candidates set up by registered un-recognized political parties-allotment of common symbol under Para 10B of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 - regarding.

Sir,


I am directed to state that the applications of the following 3 (three) registered un-recognised political parties for concession of allotment of common symbol to their candidates being set up for the current general election to Legislative Assembly of Goa, 2012 under the provisions of Para 10B of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, have been accepted by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission has decided to extend the concession sought under Para 10B to the candidates of the said 3 (three) political parties for the current general election to Legislative Assembly of Goa, 2012, in the constituencies mentioned against their names in the table below:-

The Returning Officers of the above mentioned Assembly Constituencies be directed to allot the common symbol mentioned above to the candidates duly setup by the aforesaid 3 (three) registered un-recognised political parties, subject to fulfillment of the provisions of Para 13 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 relating to setting up of candidates by the parties. It may also be noted that said common symbols allotted to the candidates of these 3 (three) parties are not allotted by oversight to any other candidate in these constituencies. However, the said symbols shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in all other constituencies, and in the constituencies where the aforesaid parties do not actually set up their candidates.

3. In the event of the above said parties failing to meet the requirement of minimum number of candidates, as prescribed in Para 10 B of the said Symbols Order, 1968, i.e. 10% of total number of Assembly Constituencies and minimum 5 ACs in the State Goa, then the said common symbol shall not be available to its candidates.

It may be noted that if the Party does not set up candidates in the prescribed number of constituencies, the facility of common symbol will be withdrawn, and the Commission will initiate action against the Party for making a false declaration before it.*
