SRO –314 - In exercise of the powers conferred by section 168 of the Jammu and Kashmir Representation of the People Act 1957, the Government after consulting the Election Commission, hereby makes the following rules to amend the Jammu and Kashmir Conduct of election Rules, 1965, namely :-

- (1) Short title and commencement (1) These rules may be called the Jammu and Kashmir Conduct of Elections (Second Amendment) Rules, 2002.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the government Gazette.
2. Amendment of rule 4 – in rule 4 of the Jammu and Kashmir Conduct of election Rules, 1965 (hereinafter referred to as the ‘Principal Rules’) for the words “as may be appropriate” the words “as may be appropriate along with an affidavit in form 2 – D “ shall be substituted.
