## EC holds meeting on State polls

**NEW DELHI:** The Election Commission on Thursday held an all-party meeting in Dimapur in Nagaland in connection with the ensuing Assembly polls in the State.

It was chaired by Chief Election Commissioner V.S. Sampath and attended by Election Commissioners H.S. Brahma and S.N.A. Zaidi.

Mr. Sampath told from Dimapur that the Commission would hold discussions on Friday with the top government/police officers of Nagaland on the poll preparedness and then move to Tripura and Meghalaya where similar discussions would be held.

The elections in the three North-Eastern States are due as the term of their Assemblies will end in March.

Each of the three Assemblies has a strength of 60 members.
