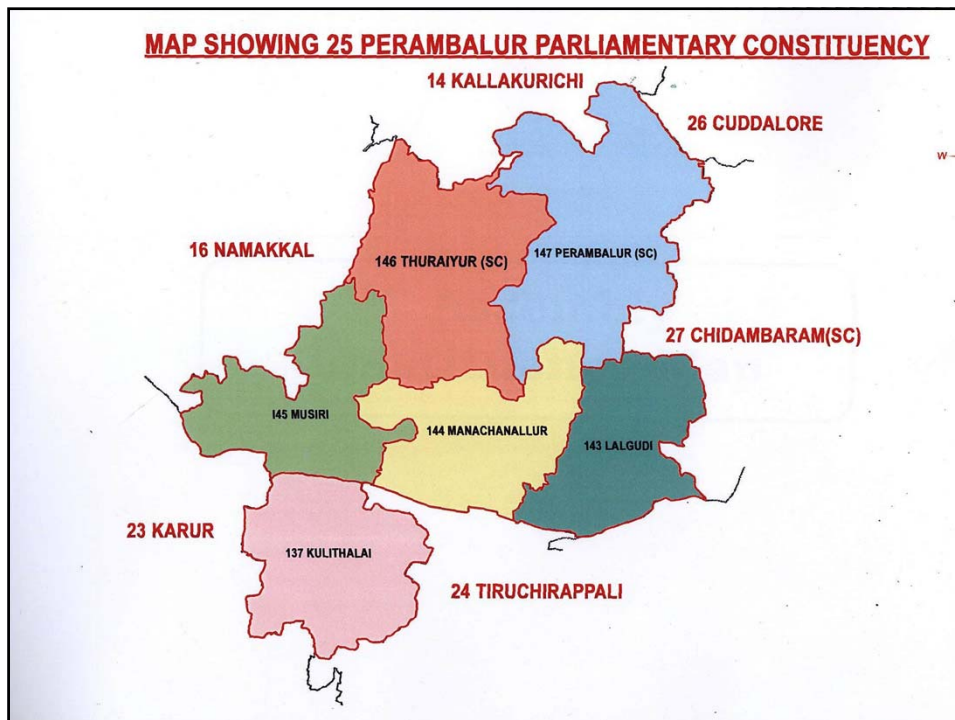

OUTCOMES

- Polling Percentage : 80.02% with 3rd position among 39 constituencies of Tamilnadu.
- Postal Ballot receipt among polling personnel: achievement was 90.7%.
- No re-poll in any booth across the constituency.
- Expenditure monitoring has yielded results with One candidate surpassing EC expenditure limit by 24 lakhs. (Approx. 64 Lakhs difference between Shadow register and Candidate's account. Notice issued explanation not accepted reported to ECI)

TEAM BUILT AROUND ARO'S

- Constituency spread across three districts.
- ARO's trained personally by RO
- Group SMS created for all level of officers.
- Skype/NIC facilities used to communicate through VC.
- Con-call facilities used on a regular basis as a follow up for SMS.

ZONAL OFFICERS-TOT

- Selection done meticulously.
- Appointed 6 months before.
- Familiar with their route, L&O issues and PS
- Back bone of elections in the field level.
- Written tests conducted and non performers eliminated.
- Thorough with working of EVM's
- Revenue and RD used in enforcement role, ZO's drafted based on quality and no departmental consideration. (Education, Agri, co-op, etc.)

TRAINING SCHEDULE

- Training of AROs by RO modeled on CEO's training given to DEO's
- Training to all Zonal officers by RO at respective AC's.
- Training to Polling Personnel attended by RO.
- Training to Micro Observers by the DEO
- Training of counting staff by the RO based on CEO training material.

TRAINING OF POLLING PERSONNEL

- Ten polling teams per room, AV facilities in every room and EVM's mobilized for hands on training- one per every two rooms.
- Examination hall format adopted for training center (Hall ticket/appointment order)


TRAINING OF POLLING PERSONNEL CONTD...

- Hall number mentioned in the appointment order.
- Bulk SMS facilities used to communicate with polling personnel regarding all aspects of training. (1SMS-10p)
- Feed back Test conducted at the end of training- Peer evaluation done monitored by ZO's.
- Emphasis was done for ensuring seating of polling party as a team.
- Hands on training given on filling up of all forms
- Ensured final training finished before Noon to give ample time to reach PS.

SUGGESTIONS:

- A web portal for polling personnel shall be created constituency wise. Provision to generate the application for postal ballot/ EDC, intimation letter for training, order of appointment shall be included.
- This portal shall be mapped with Electoral Roll portal to fetch the data of SI:No in voter list, Part No and AC number and name so that Form 12& 12A can be generated automatically.
- SMS alert and e-mail shall be sent to them after completion of each randomization.
- SIM card for Polling Personnel shall be provided according to the availability of network in a Zone. At present, BSNL card is provided to all PS.
