CHAPTER-I

OVERVIEW OF SIKKIM STATE SYSTEMATIC VOTERS' EDUCATION AND ELECTORAL PARTICIPATION (SVEEP) ACTION PLAN

1.1 BRIEF OVERVIEW

In a vibrant democracy voting is an important tool for manifestation of will and choices of citizens in the matter of governance. In a sense, participation an active involvement in the electoral process symbolizes the freedom of citizen which is the essence of any democracy. Voter's participation in electoral process in any democratic setup is the basic ingredient for making informed choices and exercising ones right to vote. To achieve the ultimate goal of successful participation, the registration of citizen as voters is an important prerequisite to their participation in the election process and is as important as holding free and fair elections. To have every eligible citizen on the voter list and to get every elector to vote is the mandate of Election Commission of India (ECI).

Sikkim State general assembly elections and Lok Sabha Elections are due in April-May, 2014. Hence, there is a need to enhance the participation of citizen in electoral process. Historically, Sikkim has witnessed a good voter turnout percentage of voting. In the last assembly election held during 2009 voter turnout percentage was recorded at 82 %. The necessity for enhanced voter participation in Sikkim election is no more a matter of debate as far as the state of Sikkim is concerned. Although Sikkim boast up of a fairly good literacy rate of 86.2%, there may be gap between what a citizen/voter should know and what they actually know in important areas like registration/EPIC/identity proofs/polling station location/ use of EVMs/ timing of polls and do's & don'ts. These gaps exists perhaps on account of voter education has not received the requisite priority and coverage from the election managers in past. The awareness levels need to be enhanced specially amongst the freshly eligible youth, uneducated, socially & economically weaker/ deprived section of society. Motivation has to be provided for the citizens who are apathetic, skeptical, dis-enthused, dis-interested to participate in the electoral process by providing suitable communication interventions, the facilitation for the registration and subsequently voting during elections.

It has been realized that there is a need to cover the last mile, where the issues like healthy- error free and complete electoral rolls, urban apathy, gender gap in participation and

youth disconnect to the electoral process are to be taken up. Participation based on individual motivation and awareness & awareness measures by election management machinery rather than compulsory voting needed to be encouraged and key to this is providing adequate and relevant information to voter motivating them and also facilitating them to register as a voter and participate in the election process.

1.2 SVEEP – BRIEF HISTORY

SVEEP is Systematic Voter's Education and Electoral Participation Program. During Jharkhand Elections, on the direction of ECI a programme called Voter Education and Electoral Participation, (SVEEP) was launched and it had a tremendous turnout during assembly election.

The programme was redesigned and re-launched as Systematic Voter's Education and Electoral Participation Program, SVEEP during assembly election in 2010 and it met with resounding success by way of the across the board increase in voter turnout during assembly election.

Over the period of time the SVEEP has bloomed into a major programme aimed to increase voter registration and electoral participation, amongst the poll manager across all states under the able guidance of Election Commission of India. The Election Commission of India has now directed for a targeted, quantifiable SVEEP Phase-II ahead of next Assembly and General Elections to Lok sabha. This program will suitably cover and serve general election to state assembly election and general election in the year 2013, 2014 and create the outreach platform for successive elections.

1.3 SVEEP : SCOPE AND COMPONENTS

As per direction of Election Commission of India several CEOs engaged survey agencies in the past fourteen election going state for doing baseline process and end line survey to understand the reasons for under-registrations, problems in updation of electoral roll, EPIC take off, low voter turnout and to identify the demographics of lower voter participation so that proper intervention can be carried out to ensure that all people irrespective of their social and economic background get an opportunity to participate in electoral process. Constitution of India entrusts the responsibility of holding free and fair elections to the Election Commission of India. In the Systematic Education & Electoral Participation (SVEEP) an emphasis is given to all aspects of voter education and awareness regarding rights of voters aimed towards improving electoral participation and electoral registration in our democratic set up. Activities under SVEEP can be broadly divided into three components:- namely Electoral Registration, Voting at Elections and Ethical , informed & inducement free Voting. SVEEP is now being institutionalized to achieve the above objectives.

SVEEP comprises systematic interventions for information, motivation and facilitations (IMF) measures to involve the people in the electoral process. Process of identification of activities for information, motivation and facilitation of citizens by way of situation or gap analysis has become a standard tool. SVEEP is a multi-faceted & multi sectoral activity involving inputs, assistance and cooperation from various government, semi- government departments, educational institutes, NGOs and CSOs, media agencies, Resident Welfare Associations, clubs and even individuals.

CHAPTER -II

SVEEP ACTION PLAN FOR OF SIKKIM-2014

2.1 GENERAL PROFILE OF SIKKIM

- I. Sikkim became the part of Indian Union only on 16th May, 1974 as 22nd State of India. It is a landlocked state situated in the north-eastern region of India. It is the second smallest state in terms of area after Goa and the least populous state of the country. The state shares international borders with China, Nepal and Bhutan, and state boundary with West Bengal.

The geography of Sikkim is diverse owing to its location in Himalayan mountain regions. It is one of the prosperous states of India owing to its political stability and economic growth. The state has varied geographical features in form of high mountain peaks and steep river valleys.

The state of Sikkim has rich cultural heritage which reflects in its traditions and customs. The culture of Sikkim is accentuated by many art and craft forms practiced by the people. The people of Sikkim also are divided into three main ethnic groups of Lepcha, Bhutia and Nepali residing together in harmony. The people also celebrate many festivals of Sikkim throughout the year. In addition to that, there are different graceful dance forms which are performed during festivals and occasions. The

cultural essence of Sikkim is also reflected in the different cuisine types which are prepared by the local people.

The state has also become one of India's preferred destinations for nature lovers. The land is replete with forests, mountains, lakes, Buddhists monasteries and so on. The major commonly spoken languages in Sikkim are Bhutia, Lepcha, Nepali, Hindi and English. Most of the regional languages of Sikkim have been given official language status in the State. Buddhism and Hinduism are dominant religions in the State.

3.2 EP RATIO OF ELECTORS

The electors to population ratio (EP) gives a measure of as to how many eligible persons in population have been enrolled as voters. The population taken to analyze the EP is the projected population in the year 2013 based on the growth rate given in the census data. The EP ratio helps in indicating the possible gaps, either of under registration or presence of duplicate voters.

As per the above table the EP Ratio of Roll is 57.54 and EP Ratio of Population is 57.77 which shows the gap of 0.23 and 18-19 age group population is 29777 and 18-19 age group in roll is 11903, there is a gap of 17879. The gender ratio of population is 889 whereas the gender ratio of roll is 940 which is higher than the gender ratio of population.

As can be seen from the table above there appears a significant gap of electors under the age group of 18-19 years. Against the expected value of 4.78 % of the total population, the actual electors under the age group of 18-19 are only 1.91%. There is a difference of 2.87% which is translated to 17884 voters under age group of 18-19 yet to be registered. However it is stated that the actual capturable normative percentage on account of eligibility for registration being 01st of January of every year as a result about 10 months are lost even after completing age of 18 years as registration only is done usually for people turning 18 during Summary Revisions.

In Sikkim there has been steady progress in enrollment of young voters under the age group of 18-19.

3.7 VOTER TURNOUT IN PREVIOUS ASSEMBLY ELECTIONS:

Voter turnout percentage during the previous elections indicates the level of participation of the voters and is important information to analyze the poor turnout or high turnout and the demographic features and other conditions associated. The analysis help in chalking out the strategies for improving the voter turnout and also gives inside about the reasons, factors affecting the voter.

In Sikkim, the voter turnout has been historically very good and the voter turnout percentage in 2009 General Election is 81.72% The voter turnout percentages since first General Election held during 1997 to till last election is as under:-

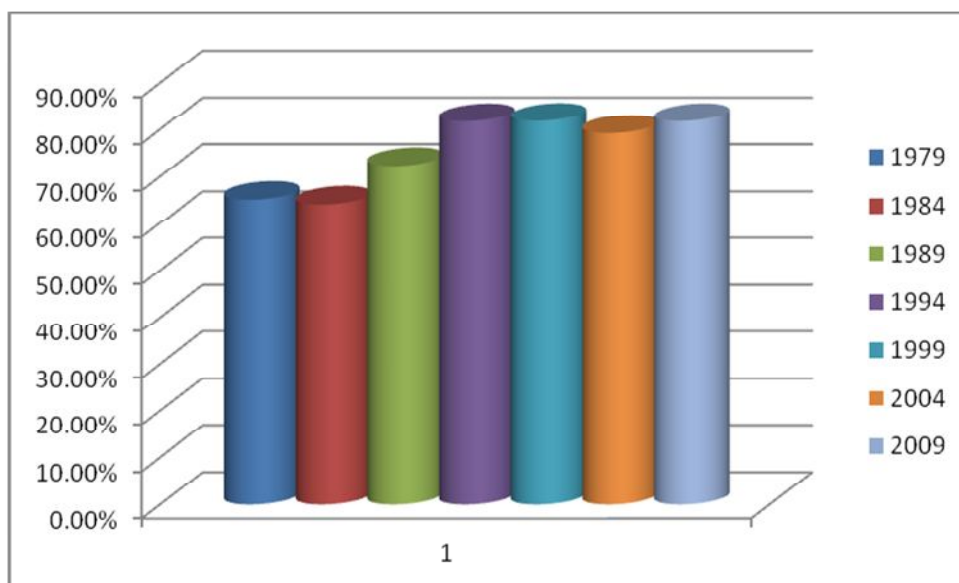

As per the table above, all the assembly constituencies had recorded more than 80-70% voter turnout except Sangha constituency which had secured 64.91 % voter turnout in 2009 Assembly Election. Sangha Constituency in Sikkim being a unique phenomenon in Indian democracy. It is a non territorial constituency to facilitate all the lama voters of Sikkim to enjoy their voting rights. Next lowest voter turnout constituencies were Gangtok (BL), Arithang, Namchi-Singhithang and Upper Tadong. Voter turnout in these constituencies were also 70% and above. This shows the voter turnout in Sikkim has improved as compared to previous elections.

3.10 WOMEN VOTER TURNOUT

The above data shows the percentage of women voter turnout in the 2009 Sikkim Assembly Election remained better than male voter turnout.

The highest women voter turnout was in Lachen Mangan(BL) assembly constituency (AC-31) where women voter turnout was 90.59%.The lowest women turnout was recorded in 32-Sangha Constituency the reason being almost all the lamas were male and very few of them are women. In almost all the constituencies' women voter turnout was above 80%. The lowest women voter turnout except Sangha was recorded in Gangtok (BL) constituency that was also better than male voter turnout i.e. 65.89: 70.68 percentages.
