Sub:- General Election to the Legislative Assembly of Tripura, 2013- Concession to candidates set up by registered unrecognized political parties- allotment of common symbol under Para 10B of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968- Regarding.

Sir,

I am directed to state that the application of the Indigenous People's Front of Tripura, a registered un-recognized political party for concession in the allotment of a common symbol to its candidates being set up to current election to Legislative Assembly of Tripura under the provisions of para 10B of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968, has been accepted by the Commission. Accordingly, the Commission has decided to extend the concession sought under Para 10B to candidates of the aforesaid party for the current General Election to Legislative Assembly of Tripura, 2013, in the constituencies mentioned under:-

2. The Returning Officers of the above mentioned Assembly Constituencies be directed to allot the common symbols mentioned above to the candidates set up by the aforesaid one registered un-recognised political party, subject to fulfillment of the provisions of Para 13 of the Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 relating to

setting up of candidates by the party. It may also be noted that said common symbol allotted to the candidates of this party is not allotted by oversight to any other candidate in these constituencies. However, the said symbols shall be available for allotment as free symbol to other candidates in all other constituencies, and in the constituencies where the aforesaid party does not actually set up their candidates.

3. In the event of the above said party failing to meet the requirement of the minimum number of candidates, as prescribed in Para 10B of the said Symbols Order, 1968, i.e., 10% of total number of Assembly Constituencies in the State, then the said common symbol shall not be available to its candidates.
